

Peter Nicholson has been head of investigations at the Athletics Integrity Unit of the IAAF since November 2017, and also the Ethics Commissioner for the International Cricket Council based in Dubai, since March 2015. Beforehand, he was in Moscow for 18 months, working for the World Anti-Doping Agency rebuilding the Russian Anti-Doping Agency RUSADA. Earlier, he spent a year as Vice-Chairman of a Commission for the International Cycling Union in Switzerland, investigating corruption and doping in international cycling from 2014/15.

Earlier in his career, he was a UK military intelligence officer in the rank of Major, then worked as an investigator for 9 years at the UN Yugoslav Tribunal, and 4 years at the International Criminal Court, including a spell as Chief of Investigations at the United Nations Investigation Commission in Lebanon. He also worked in Australia as a senior investigator for ASIC for 2 years, and then living in Pakistan for 2 years working on counter-terrorism, counter-extremism and justice sector reform with the Pakistani Government and EU. He then worked for Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade in Uruzgan, Afghanistan for 2 years, working on stabilisation and security sector reform. In 2015/16, spent a year investigating war crimes and crimes against humanity in Syria and Iraq for EU governments. Peter holds an LLM and MBA, and is a member of the Western Australia Red Cross International Humanitarian Law Committee.
